Here are our walks for October and November.

 Wednesday, Oct 5, 5:30PM – Raccoon River Park Nature Lodge, 2500 Grand Ave, West Des Moines. This is part of the 12th Annual Healthiest State Annual Walk. We will be joining thousands of other Iowans statewide in walking for 30 minutes. Workplaces, schools, organizations, and cities all create walks, and we have too!! We'll loop the lake, which iss little more than 30 minutes, but it's a fun, easy trail, and we'll eat out afterwards.

- Thursday, Oct 13, 1:00PM Deerfield Retirement Center, 13731 Hickman Rd, Urbandale. Let's all meet behind the Center, where there's public parking in the (western) rear. The park is noted for its open sky, greenery, and friendly deer. A George-led walk.
- Monday, Oct 17, 10:30AM Urbandale Trails. Start/finish at McDivitt Cemetery, 7001 Meredith Dr, Urbandale. Park along 70th St. We'll explore the extensive Urbandale trails.
- Wednesday, Oct 19, 10:00AM Walnut Creek Trail. Meet at the soccer field parking lot behind Pal Joey's, 6224 Grand Avenue, Des Moines. We'll be enjoying our second Art Corridor walk. A Public Art Grant from Bravo Greater Des Moines has allowed Des Moines Parks and Recreation to install five art corridors along the Central Iowa Trail System within Des Moines. The corridors feature art selected from 64 submissions from 40 local artists. Trail users will view art from both directions of travel. We will enjoy the artwork along the Carl Voss Trail near Easter Lake.
- Tuesday, Oct 25, 4:00PM Carr Park, 1704 Meadowlane Ave, Ames. Carr Park is in the midst of neighborhoods and runs next to River Valley Park. The goal is to explore the trail covered in fallen leaves and enjoy the scents of fall. Join us for an enjoyable outing.
- Friday, Oct 28, 10:00AM Waveland Neighborhood. We'll meet at the Waveland Tennis Courts, 4822 Observatory Road, Des Moines. Currently, there is construction in that area, so you may need to park along Polk Boulevard. We'll gather at the Waveland Tennis Court sign and enjoy a stroll through the Waveland neighborhood.
- Monday, Oct 31, 6:30PM Sherman Hill District's Annual Halloween on the Hill. Please join us for this special event and fundraiser for DMRC. Meet at Hoyt Sherman Place (15th and

Woodland) at the stairs leading to the ticket door on the east side of the building). Everyone is asked to donate a non-perishable food item(s) when they arrive. We will drop off our DMRC food donations and pick up our map, including the neighborhood's largest Halloween displays, at the start. This event is for all ages, but it is all trick and no treats.
