**Program:** Jo Kay Boyle gave a presentation of her hike in Nepal with Above and Beyond, whose mission is to encourage those touched by cancer.

**Presidents Report:** Diana Ronk reminded the members of the Wednesday walks coming up and of the time change and start point change for the group Oktoberfest Walk in Valley Junction and that the sign up for the walk is through the AARP website.

**Tales from the Trails:** Phyllis Olson reported that the Walk Six Counties in South Dakota walks were cancelled because of rain but they were able to do 4 walks while there. The Wandering Wheels Club from Ohio stopped in Davenport for the walk and said it was a favorite. There was 37 walkers, 26 credit and the 11 non-credit, at the Brewery Walk September 7, and Meals from the Heartland had 10 volunteers from our club and did 20 cases of meals.

**Old Business:** Diana Ronk opened a discussion for changing the monthly meeting time from 7:00 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. Motion was made by Diana Whited to change to 6:30 p.m. for winter hours only, specifically November through April.
